(15) Junior Matches

Matches are arranged annually with the Ladies Captain and the Senior sections.

These are normally 4BBB matches with 12 in each team.

This is an opportunity to introduce new handicap players to both Match competitions and to mix with Adult members of the Club.

It has been common practice for the Ladies and the Majors to treat the juniors to a light meal in the Clubhouse at the conclusion of the match.

Matches are also arranged with other Clubs. Traditionally with have played Ipswich and Stoke-by-Nayland home and away on alternative years. Other Clubs have been included recently; they are Haverhill, Frinton, Rushmere and Felixstowe.

The Junior Organiser will normally arrange the Match and agree the venue.

Teams The Junior Captain will be responsible for choosing the team Players.

(16) The John Cusworth Plate

The Junior Captain invites all 9-hole course players to a Texas scramble on the 18 hole Course. This event normally occurs at the end of December each year.

Format This is a Texas Scramble Competition over 8/10 holes of Golf

followed by Christmas lunch in the clubhouse.

Teams to consist of **3 or 4** players and be a mixture of 18 hole Junior Club Members and 9 hole players.

All Players Drive and the best ball is chosen, teams of 3 **all** play their shot from this spot, teams of 4, **only 3** players to be used.

This competition is **not a Qualifier** for handicap adjustment.
